

Distributing Flyers and Cards with Information about COVID Vaccination for Children

Thank you for helping to share information for parents as they decide whether to choose COVID vaccination for their children. Together we can support parents across the United States!

Accessing and Printing Flyers and Cards

The National Coalition for Health Integrity has created simple flyers and cards which you can download, print, and share. To download them go to www.AskHealthyQuestions.com/flyers.

- The flyers can be printed in color or black-and-white on a home printer, or at a print shop. They are four-to-a-page, two-sided, and will need to be cut.
- The cards are business-card sized. We suggest you get a batch of them printed through an affordable printer.
- One useful resource for printing cards and flyers affordably is sharpdots.com. For example, the cards can be printed for ~\$60 for 1000 cards.

Placing Flyers and Cards

With ongoing censorship, getting a physical piece of information into someone's hands is a powerful way to share knowledge. Please be sensitive as you decide how and where to distribute these materials. Laws and regulations vary from place to place. For example, in some places it is legal to post flyers on telephone poles, and in some places it is not.

Note: When you distribute materials, you alone assume any liability.

However, sometimes it's better to ask forgiveness than permission. Listen to your gut about what will and will not be ok.

Always be polite and professional when distributing materials, or if asked to leave.

Suggestions of where and how you can share the flyers and cards. Please check your local laws and regulations:

- Post on bulletin boards. Ask permission if needed.
- Hand out or place on windshields in parking lots.
- Hand out flyers and cards at rallies, fairs, and public events. We suggest you say something simple like "This information is about children's health," then hand them the card or flyer and walk away. Often it works best if you do not get into a discussion about the material. They can go to the website for more information.
- Leave small stacks of flyers and cards on counters in public places such as stores, gas stations, etc. You may want to do this unobtrusively and leave only a few at a time.
- The cards can be left door-to-door in neighborhoods by sliding them into crack between the door and jamb.

Do Not Give Up

Giving out flyers and cards can sometimes seem intimidating, especially when people have negative responses. Remember that almost half the adults in the U.S. still have not gotten vaccinated. So, for all the people who disagree with you, there are many who would like to connect with someone who is like-minded. Many parents are feeling alone and need help, information, and support. So, please do not give up. **The kids are worth it.**
