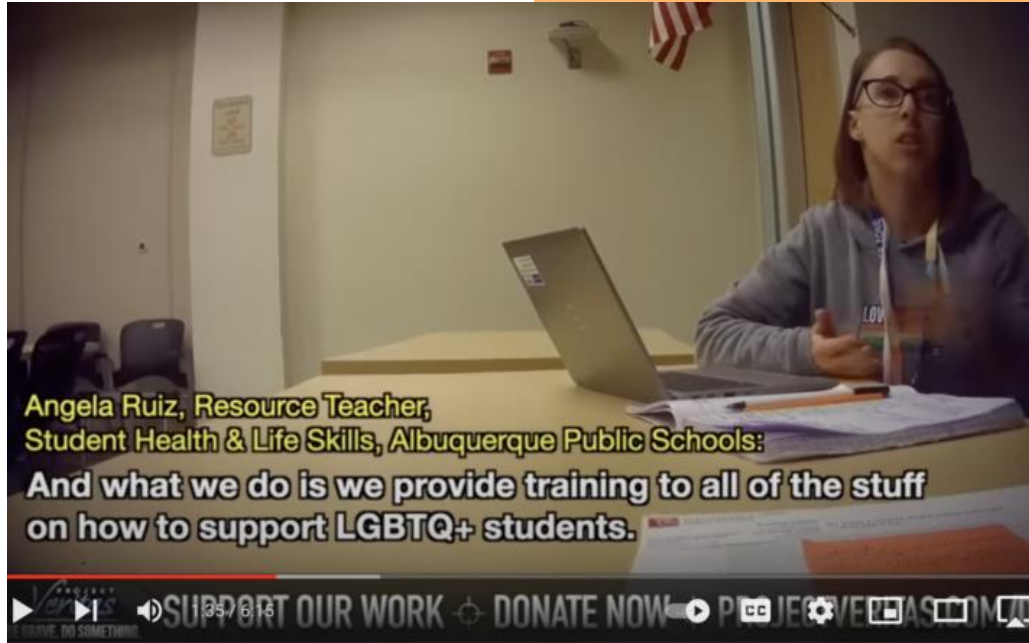

Pronouns

Many teachers routinely ask kids what pronouns they want to use, even for children as young as elementary school.



Gender Support Plans



Schools have developed gender support plans for students without parental notification.

Hiding Student Gender Identity

Teachers will use different names and pronouns for kids without telling parents.

This includes changing the student's name and gender in electronic classroom records, with notes to indicate when parents do not know about the child's gender identity.

HOW TO NORMALIZE PRONOUN USE

- Introductions
- Name tags
- Ask about pronouns/names
- Screen names

REMEMBER

- Ask what students are called at home
- Be very mindful of not "outing" students

APS Gender Identity Policy and Procedural Directive

- Students shall have the right to be addressed by name and pronouns corresponding to their gender identity.

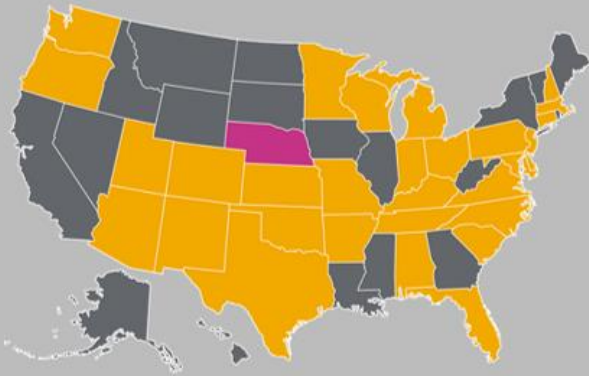


GLSEN

RAINBOW LIBRARY

Over 4,600 schools in 30 states participate in GLSEN's Rainbow Library, reaching over 2.5 million students

Rainbow Libraries

Over 4,600 schools in 30 states have “rainbow libraries” of books that encourage gender confusion from Kindergarten through 12th grade.

Teacher Training

Teachers are being trained to believe that gender is just a social construct.

Busting nonbinary myths

- ✓ **Anyone** can use **any** pronouns.
- ✓ There are **no expression requirements**.
- ✓ Nonbinary means a **million different things** to a million different people.
- ✓ You **can't tell** whether someone is trans/nonbinary unless they tell you.

Ungendering Language

Students are being trained to “ungender” language by avoiding use of words such as Mom, Dad, brother, sister, etc.

Microaggression

A statement, action, or incident that delivers indirect, subtle, or unintentional discrimination against members of a marginalized group.

* Microaggressions have a macro affect. Regardless of the name, discrimination is still discrimination.



Here they are equating the use of the usual gender pronouns with discrimination

Slides from Ungendering Language

Uninclusive wording

English: dude, girl/gurl/gorl, guys, ladies, mom, dad, sister, brother, niece, nephew

Spanish: “-o, -os, -a, -as,” Latino/a, amigo/a, “a todos,” el/la, hermano/a, esposo/a, madre, padre, “Estoy cansado/a”

*Avoid gendering objects altogether

Let's try these instead!

English: Mx., friend, sibling, nibling, person, everyone, friends, icons, scholars, my community, people, folks, y'all, loved ones, parent

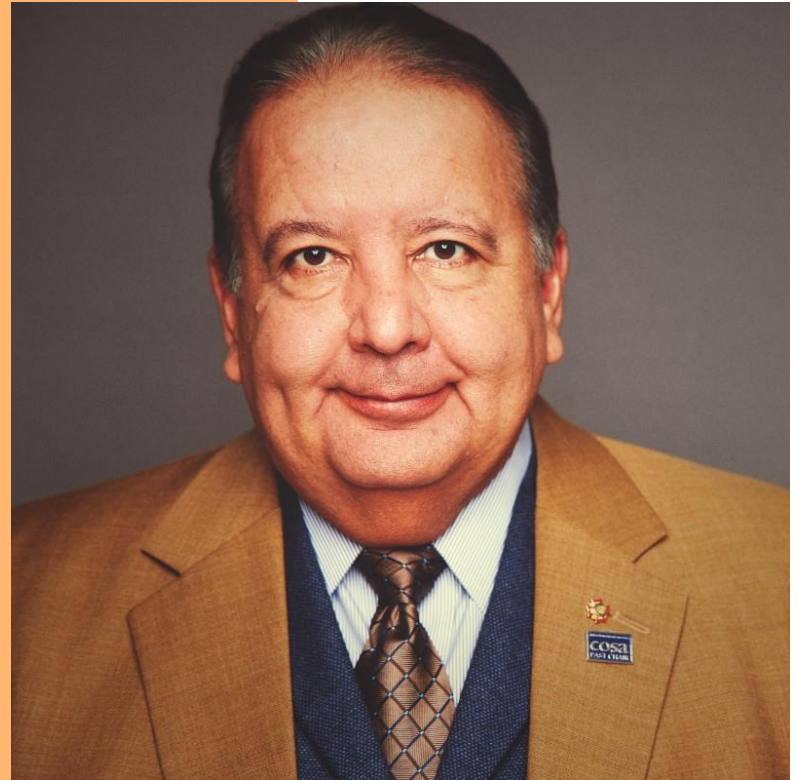
Spanish: “-e/es, -x, -i/is, -@, -u/us,” Latinx, amigue, les/lues, espose, abuel@, niñx, hermane, les padres, “Estoy cansadx”




School Board Training

We'll create a gender-affirming "closet" with clothing that will help trans students access clothing that fits their true selves and identities.

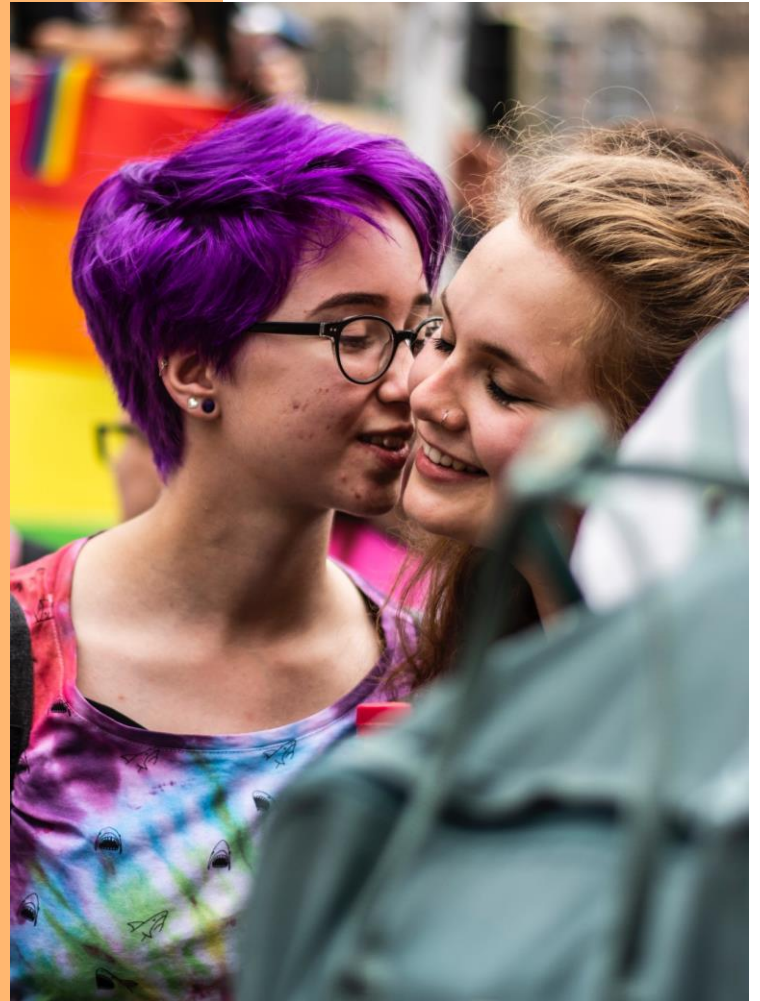
Multiple schools have received \$10,000 grants to build gender closets, where students can change their gender identity at school.

Autism and Mental Health



There are higher rates of autism, ADHD, bipolar disorder, obsessive compulsive disorder, depression, and schizophrenia in people who identify as transgender.

Social Media

In almost 2/3 of cases, internet and social media usage increased prior to adolescents coming out as trans.

Trans vs Gay/Lesbian

88% of transgender boys grow out of it and grow up to be homosexual.

92% of girls who de-transition are lesbian or bi-sexual.

Gender affirmation and girls' rights

Bathrooms and Locker Rooms

In many schools, trans students are allowed to use bathrooms and locker rooms that do not match their biological gender.

This threatens girls' rights to privacy and security.



Males Competing Against Girls

Girls are being put at a disadvantage as biologically-male transgender people are competing in girls' sports. Males are physiologically stronger and more powerful.

Health risks of gender transition

Preferred Pronouns

Using children's preferred names or pronouns is "not a neutral act" and could be as severe an act as altering their bodies.

Medical Gender Transition

Puberty blockers, hormones, and surgery “are generally irreversible and have a high probability of causing sterilization.”

Medical Gender Transition

Puberty blockers, hormones, and surgery increase the risks of:

- Heart problems
- Venous thromboembolism
- High blood pressure
- Reduced bone density, osteoporosis, and fractures
- Significantly increased weight
- Hormone-dependent cancers

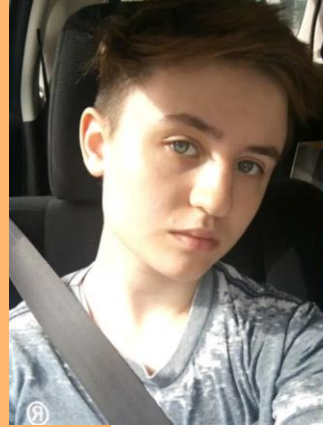

Detransition

It's hard to get solid data because this is so new. Studies are looking at older generations.

There are online detransition groups with 25,000+ members.



Detransition

Many effects are permanent and cannot be reversed:

- Misdirected puberty and development
- Voice changes
- Mastectomy
- Genital surgery
- Sterility

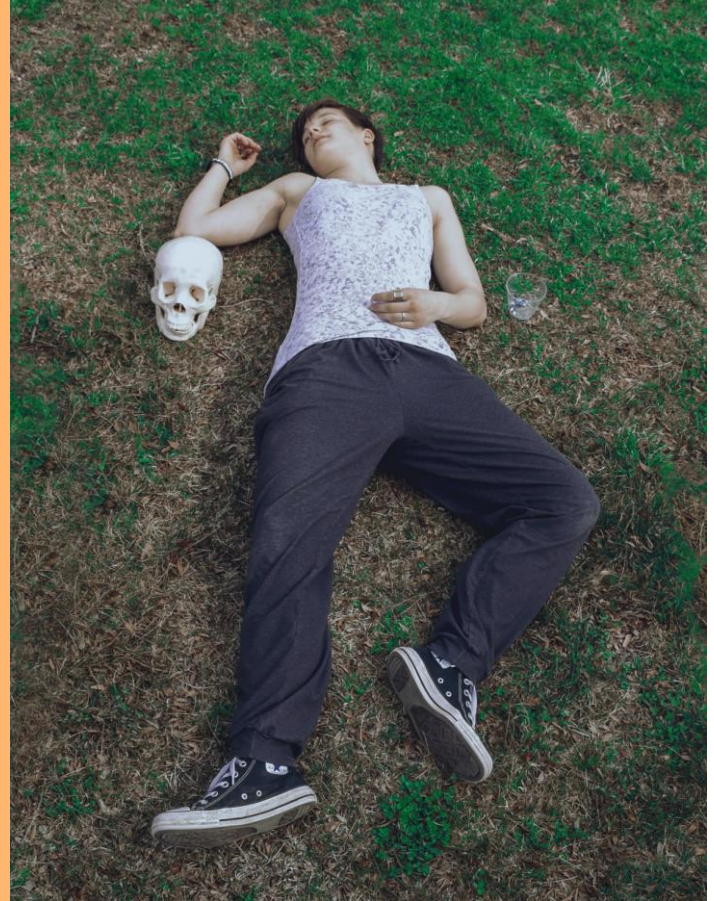




Gender transition and suicide

A Big Lie

Parents are being deceived that gender transition will reduce the risk of their child committing suicide.



30-Year Study

Transgender people have a tendency towards lifelong mental health problems.

10-15 years after gender reassignment, suicide rate rose to 20 times that of peers.

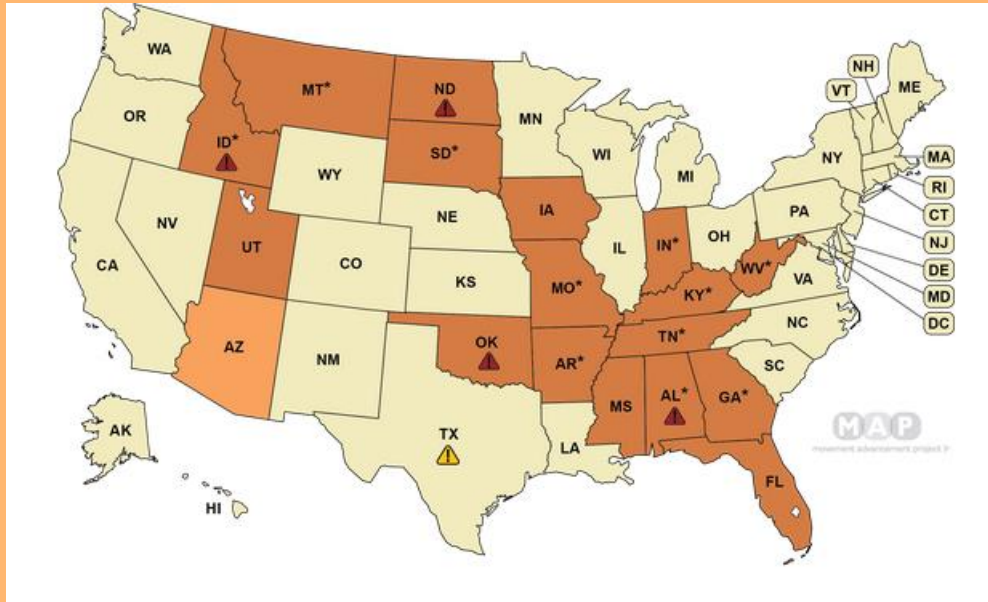
Call for Moratorium on Transgender Treatment for Children



There should be no medical gender treatment for children under 18 years old.

There should be extensive counseling, therapy, and time required before medical gender transition is undertaken.

Laws Against Transgender Treatment for Children

**How to
help save
the kids**

Be Proactive

Talk with kids and grandkids to make sure they have a safe person to talk to.

Prevent or carefully monitor social media usage.

Talk to teachers and school admins.



Consider Home or Private School

Homeschooling is not as hard as people think. It only takes 1-2 hours daily for K-5 kids.

There are homeschool groups and co-ops available nationwide.



Distribute Cards Locally

Hand out these cards or leave them in places where people will find them:

- on cars in parking lots
- at front doors
- in stores



Parents: Beware of the trans agenda in our schools! It is being hidden from you on purpose.



Schools are encouraging kids to question their gender, without telling parents.

Gender confusion is rare, and 4 out of 5 children who experience it grow out of it.

Medical gender transition (hormones, breast removal, castration) does NOT reduce the risk of suicide. Known gender transition risks include sterility, cancer, heart disease, and a lifetime of remorse.
